## Aunt Martha's Extravagance

Part 7 – Sneaking in a Beach Trip?

Via a Mississippi Open Records Act request, USMNEWS.net recently obtained a large batch of documents from USM relating to USM president Martha Saunders' university aircraft. This series, *Aunt Martha's Extravagance*, provides analysis of these documents. This installment examines the 18-March-2010 trip in the USM airplane taken by Saunders to make a "SACS Reaffirmation Visit" and to attend "Bond Request meetings." That invoice is inserted below, and it indicates that USM charged itself \$5,040 for Saunders to take this recent trip.

One would expect that a bond request meeting would occur in Jackson, MS. Indeed, the invoice above notes that one leg of Saunders' trip was to Jackson. Another leg was to Blacksburg, VA, which one would believe to be the location of the SACS reaffirmation visit. Why, then, was there a third leg of the trip? There was – as the invoice notes that Saunders and the plane stopped off in Pensacola, FL. Of course, long-time readers of USMNEWS.net will recall that one of Saunders' <u>favorite places</u> is her vacation home near Pensacola Beach (see insert below).



The idea that Saunders may have used USM resources for *personal benefit* – to perhaps "stop by" her beach house using "USM Air" – is not surprising to many long-time readers. One has only to revisit the USMNEWS.net Archives for a page of reports about former SoA director James Crockett's taxpayer-subsidized family vacations to see how some USM administrators treat their access to government coffers.
