UH-Victoria Provost Stepping Down

HATTIESBURG – For several days, USMNEWS.net has been scrolling a tip from a source indicating that the University of Houston – Victoria's Suzanne LaBrecque is relinquishing her post as the UH-V provost. This move comes shortly after the UH-V faculty council voted overwhelmingly for a resolution of "no confidence" in LaBrecque. After a couple of days scrolling at USMNEWS.net, *The Victoria Advocate*'s Kayla Bell penned, on 20-May-2011, <u>a news report</u> entitled "UHV provost steps down after no-confidence vote," explaining the UHV administrator's reaction to the major step taken earlier by the UH-V faculty council.

As also reported earlier by USMNEWS.net, Bell's story indicates that LaBrecque will no longer serve as UH-V's provost on and after 1-June-2011, ending a five-year stint on the job. Bell also reports that LaBrecque, a tenured faculty at UH-V, will be serving as a special assistant to the Don Smith, UH-V's interim president. Weeks ago, USMNEWS.net reported that the "no confidence" vote (on LaBrecque) taken by the faculty council was overwhelming - 45 for "no confidence," 1 for "confidence," with 2 At that time, some on The Victoria Advocate's staff ridiculed abstentions. USMNEWS.net's reporting, saying that the website is not a credible source of information. This was done through the <u>online comments</u> window to TVA's own initial report on the LaBrecque "no confidence" vote. TVA also reported LaBrecque as saying that she (LaBrecque) had no plan to resign, and that she (LaBrecque) felt she was doing a superb job as provost. As sources state, the quick resignation seems to support USMNEWS.net's reporting, not TVA's. Of course, USMNEWS.net's scoop of the TVA on the resignation story only further solidifies USMNEWS.net's standing on this story.

Finally, *The Victoria Advocate* has filed an open records request of the UH-V faculty council, in hopes of getting some information on why the "no confidence" motion (regarding LaBrecque) was favored by that group. USMNEWS.net applauds *TVA* for using the open records avenue to clear up unknowns regarding this taxpayer-supported public institution (UH-V). However, sources tell USMNEWS.net that, given the tone of *TVA*'s prior reporting on this episode, possibly <u>clouded by its relation</u> to UH-V, the request was likely made to provide *TVA* with details that it can then use to denigrate UH-V's faculty council, not its provost. If those details are *fully* disclosed by *TVA*, they will, at least according to sources, likely make LaBrecque look even worse than she looks now. If something else occurs, then the UH-V faculty council will benefit from providing those details to another media outlet. As always, USMNEWS.net is open to that possibility, should it become necessary.
