

USM Softball Coaches Resign

HATTIESBURG - In a shocking move, co-head coaches of USM's softball program, Jon Malgradi and Kirsten Voak, resigned on 15-Aug-2014. As [reported in](#) *The Hattiesburg American*, the duo leaves USM with the dismal overall record of 49-106, a record that USMNEWS.net has followed throughout their time in Hattiesburg. Although the newspaper account of their departure reflects an in-control tone from the Golden Eagles athletics officials, sources point out that such a resignation, coming at the beginning of the 2014-15 academic year, is not an ordinary situation.
