## **USM Staffer Arrested for Alleged Killing**

HATTIESBURG – Jesse Bass of *The Hattiesburg American* reports on 22-May-2012 that USM staffer Linda Gwozdz has been arrested for allegedly killing her husband back in 2007, when the couple resided in Los Angeles. Gwozdz was booked into the Forrest County Jail after being arrested by the U.S. Marshals Service and the Hattiesburg Police Department. These agencies were working on behalf of the Los Angeles County Sheriff, whose department recently uncovered evidence linking Gwozdz to the 2007 killing. USM public relations official Van Arnold informed the media that Gwozdz is a clinical secretary in the Department of Speech and Hearing Sciences, a position she has held since 2010.
