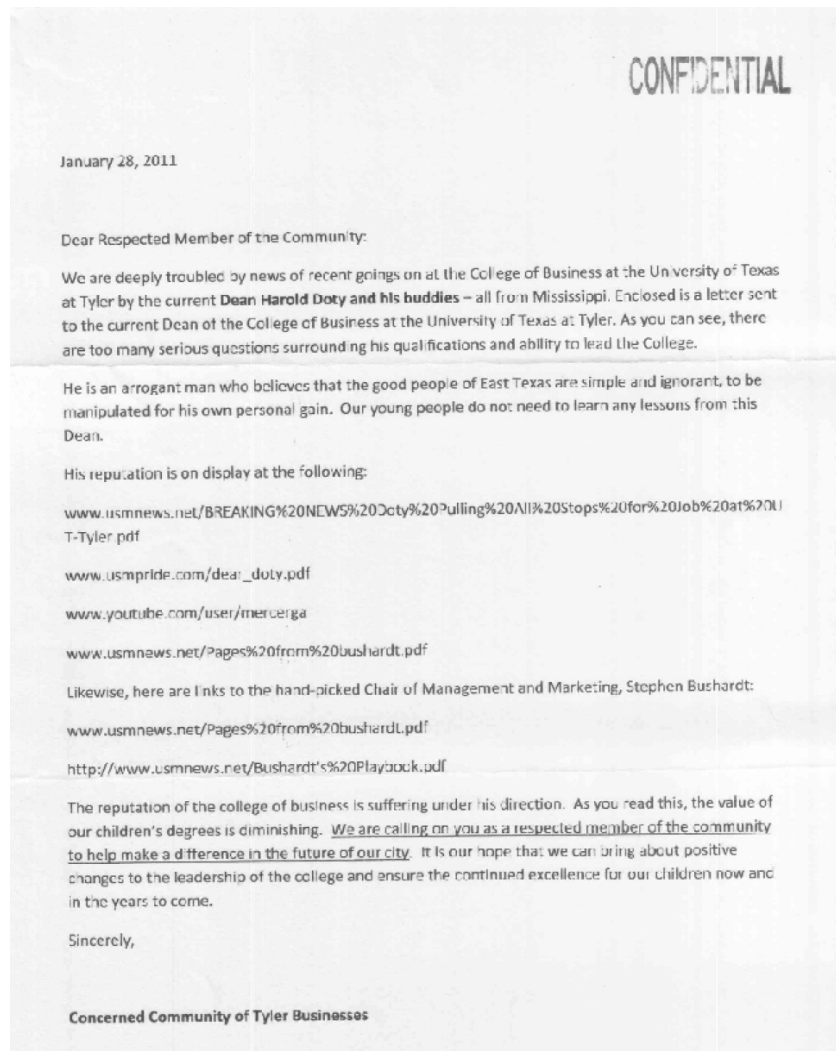

City of Tyler Getting an Education on Doty

HATTIESBURG – More troubling news is now coming out of Tyler, Texas, and the University of Texas – Tyler, concerning former USM College of Business dean Harold Doty, now the b-school dean at UT-Tyler. To add to previous reports on the chaotic situation there, USMNEWS.net has obtained an additional letter regarding the administration turmoil at UT-T. This letter, which is inserted below, was penned by a group calling itself “Concerned Community of Tyler Businesses,” and it is dated 28-Jan-2011, stamped “CONFIDENTIAL,” and addressed to “Respected Member[s] of the Community.”



In the letter above, the CCTB informs members of the greater Tyler community that the UT-T business college is being led by “. . . an arrogant man who believes that the good people of East Texas are simple and ignorant, to be manipulated for his own personal gain.” The group goes on to advise that the community fear that its youth might learn lessons from Doty. After providing references to assist community members in educating themselves about Doty and Stephen Bushardt, the controversial former USM b-school executive/professor who now heads UT-T's management department, the CCTB is requesting the assistance of the wider Tyler community is having Doty expelled from the UT-T business school dean's office.
