

Dugan to Join CoB Accounting Faculty

HATTIESBURG – Reports have been coming into the USMNEWS.net news division for some time stating that Michael Dugan, the *Ernst & Young Professor of Accounting* at the University of Alabama, will be joining the CoB's accounting faculty in 2010-11. Dugan, who earned a DBA from the University of Tennessee, has been affiliated with UA for a number of years, and is believed to be headed to Hattiesburg to become the [inaugural holder](#) of the CoB's new *Horne LLP Endowed Professorship in Accounting*.

Dugan reportedly has almost 50 academic publications, including articles in *Issues in Accounting Education*, *Financial Review*, *Journal of Business Finance and Accounting*, *Business Horizons*, *Quarterly Review of Economics and Finance*, *Journal of Accounting Education*, *Accounting History*, *Journal of Financial Research*, *Accounting Horizons*, *Auditing: A Journal of Practice & Theory*, *Academy of Accounting and Financial Studies Journal*, *Journal of Accounting Literature*, *Journal of Financial Statement Analysis*, *Journal of Business Forecasting Methods and Systems*, *Journal of Accounting, Auditing & Finance*, *Advances in Accounting*, *Journal of Applied Business Research*, and *Journal of Economic and Social Measurement*. The unique A-level publications are listed above in blue font (and the available A-journals are shown below).



Sources say that the addition of Dugan would give the CoB a three-tiered School of Accountancy, with a small group of faculty having produced respectable research. Look for future reports to explore this situation.
