Saunders Administration Grows, Yet Again

HATTIESBURG – Despite the economic and fiscal challenges facing USM and Mississippi, the Martha Saunders administration continues to grow. It grew yet again this week, as David Tisdale's 7-Dec-2010 <u>USM presser</u>, entitled "Payne Named Associate Director for External Affairs for Alumni Association," points out. According to Tisdale, Jennifer Payne, a USM speech communication graduate, has taken the position of associate director for external affairs with the USM alumni association, a job that reports to <u>Jerry DeFatta</u>, the new executive director of the USM alumni association.

Tisdale's presser also states that "Payne has spent the last three years with Southern Miss serving as the Centennial Celebration Coordinator," a position that has had her planning USM's 1910-2010 centennial celebrations and related events. Sources tell USMNEWS.net that members of the USM family, particularly USM faculty, will likely be surprised to learn that the Saunders administration has employed, for three years now, a centennial celebrations director. Some sources also state that Payne's new position almost certainly pays at least \$50,000 per year, and more likely pays at least \$75,000 per year. One source, however, suggested to USMNEWS.net that Payne's salary might be nearer \$90,000 to \$100,000, especially given that the CoB's new director of external relations, James Tisdale, is currently earning a \$90,000 annual salary. Part of the Tisdale story centers around his family connections to USM. It is not known now whether Payne is a member of the (extended) Payne family of USM financial supporters (as in the Payne Center).
