


Henthorne Leaves CoB to Lead Tourism Department at UNLV

HATTIESBURG – Reporters at USMNEWS.NET have learned that Interim Chair of MGT & MKT and Chair of Tourism Management, Tony Henthorne, will be departing USM at the close of 2007-08 in order to take on the role of Chair of the Tourism & Convention Department at the University of Nevada – Las Vegas. Not only does UNLV reside in one of the world's premier tourism destinations, Henthorne's future academic home is part of the larger *William F. Harrah College of Hotel Administration* at UNLV.



Henthorne's move is one of the finer moves made by departing CoB faculty since 2003, when former Dean Harold Doty assumed the reins of the CoB. Henthorne's career rise also provides a stark contrast to what has occurred with Doty's career since 2000, when Doty was a chair in the business school at Syracuse University.

Cited by USMNEWS.NET editorialists on numerous as the hardest working CoB departmental chair in some time, the story of Henthorne's move to UNLV's *Harrah College* is one of the more impressive in recent memory.
