Miles earned a B.S. degree from Mississippi State University in 1978, and later, in 1989, he earned a D.B.A. degree from Mississippi State University. Since 1989, Miles has served on faculty at Georgia Southern University, though he has also held visiting positions at other institutions.

Miles interviewed on the Hattiesburg campus, as did two other Management & Marketing finalists, during the week of 22-Oct-07 through 26-Oct-2007. All three of these candidates – Miles, Kirk Ring, and David Glascoff – hold (or will hold) doctorate degrees from Mississippi State University, while two of them – Ring and Glascoff – also have degrees from USM. The "homer advantage" enjoyed by Glascoff and Ring was further accentuated by the CoB administration's decision to publicly announce the time and place of Miles' on-campus research presentation a mere 10 minutes before that presentation was scheduled to begin.
