Bahmani's online c.v. indicates that she was born in Lansing, Michigan, in 1981. According to sources, both Bahmani-Oskooee and Niroomand were, at that time, economics students at Michigan State University.

If Niroomand and EFIB Search Committee Chair, Akbar Marvasti, are successful in hiring Bahmani for one of ECO's multiple openings -- an outcome sources believe will occur -- then Niroomand's return favor will result in 30 to 33.3 percent of the PhD economists on the ECO side of the EFIB having come from Iran. This outcome is interesting, given the reports available here at USMNEWS.NET that have covered "the Persianization" of various aspects of the EFIB and CoB.
