Citations in a Doty-less CoB

A Look at the Latest CoB Google Scholar Data without Harold Doty

The <u>recent report</u> about departing CoBer Harold Doty's total Google Scholar cites count of more than 2,180 opened the eyes of newer visitors to USMNEWS.net. This report looks at what is being left behind in the CoB after the dual departure of Harold (MGT) and Susan Doty (ECO), who are soon to be joining the administration and faculty at the University of Texas at Tyler. The GS citations of most of the remaining CoBers are shown below in Table 1.

Not shown above is about a 20-way tie for 45th place at 0 GS cites.

As shown in Table 1 above, FIN's James Lindley sits atop the CoB's much smaller GS citations hill at 565 GS cites. Behind Lindley, at 246 GS cites, is Lance Nail, the first-year CoB dean. In third is the *McCarty Distinguished Professor of Decision Sciences* Chang-Tseh Hsieh, with 217 GS cites, while the top 5 is rounded out by LS' Ernest King (196 GS cites) and DS' Donna Davis (161 GS cites). Davis, the fifth-place holder, is rumored to soon become the first-ever chair of BEDS (business economics and decision sciences).

Of interest in Table 1 is the fact that Yosef Bonaparte, a first-year economics faculty, has three times the number of GS cites as FIN's Matthew Hood, who is at the halfway point of a tenure-track run. Also of interest is incoming School of Accounting director Kirby Hughes, from LSU. Hughes sits in 6th, with 147 GS cites. Finally, EFIB chairman George Carter is tied for 18th (at 48 GS cites) with MGT/TM chair David Duhon, the same person Carter said belonged in K-12/Junior College education instead of in a 4-year university like USM. Their neck-and-neck academic battle (of 25 years) has been one for the ages.
