If you take a look at the <u>NCAA's release of 2012 revenue</u> <u>data</u>, there doesn't appear to have been a ground swell of support from sports contributors. In fact, 2012 contributions were a million dollars less than the high reached in 2006. (Note, there has been an increase since the contributions reached an eight year low in 2009. The 2009 contributions were \$2 million less than made in 2006.) However, mandatory student fees to support athletics have shown a steady increase.
