"An **Authorized House Counsel** is a person licensed to practice in a another state (other than Florida), a U.S. territory, or the District of Columbia who is authorized and certified by the Supreme Court of Florida to provide limited legal services in Florida while exclusively employed by a business organization located in Florida. An authorized house counsel is not a member of The Florida Bar. There are currently 717 Authorized House Counsel Members." Neither Lee Gore nor Lee P. Gore appear on the list of auzhorized house counsel. We provided links so you can check for yourself.
