Does the CoB Now Have a New SAIS Director?

The <u>8-Jan-09 entry</u> in USMNEWS.net's *GH Chatter* series mentioned that the CoB's accountants may be in "botch it up" mode when it comes to participating in CoB dean Lance Nail's plan to hire six new department chairs as part of the IHL-approved CoB reorganization (that will take effect in 2009-10). Reports are that the accountants' frustrations stem from having their desired ACC chair candidate(s) brushed aside as not suitable by the Nail administration. If such a move is afoot among the CoB's accountants, sources speculate that Nail might have to resort to appointing an internal figure to chair the accountants (or direct the SAIS).

Sources' speculation may have recently been given credence by something USMNEWS.net editorialist Duane Cobb uncovered while researching candidates for his <u>report</u> on the 2009 CoB Person of the Year award. One of the honorable mention recipients for the 2009 CoBPoY is associate professor of legal studies Ernest King. As the screen below indicates, the USM Directory now lists King as the "Director" of "Accountancy and Info. Systems" in USM's College of Business.



If King has indeed been elevated to SAIS Director, and it appears as though he may recently have been, then sources state that an announcement from Nail will likely come in the near future. That expectation comes from the belief that Nail will want the CoB's accountants and decision scientists to know well in advance that *King* will be evaluating their teaching, research and service in a few weeks.
