The controversy at issue here is that Grimes has been <u>implicated</u> in the recent <u>scandal</u> involving the USM Research Foundation's Pinion Properties. The ongoing allegation is that Grimes approved of then-Pinion Properties executive Richard Hadden's decision to spend almost \$1 million in USMRF/Pinion Properties funds to purchase shares of Saone Corporation, which was/is owned by Hadden and Helene Hadden, Richard's wife.

The idea that these kinds of encounters at USM are almost unavoidable is disturbing at best. Several Mississippi agencies/officials are now investigating the deal between Hadden's Saone Corporation and the USMRF's Pinion Properties that was signed off on by Grimes. Now, in an effort to generate some positive PR involving famed USM alumnus Buffett, Saunders is pictured next to Grimes, with both looking as happy as kids at Christmas about the recent gathering. After this, what's next?
