And in that meeting, Dean Doty and Farhang Niroomand and George Carter were going to have a discussion with me, and I showed up with an attorney and that meeting was supposed to involve the University attorney and the University provost, who did not show up to that meeting. When I arrived with my attorney, the dean made a phone call to the University attorney's office and could not get the University attorney to come over to the meeting. So since I had an attorney at the meeting. At the point where I stood up to leave, Dr. Niroomand pointed his finger at me and began shouting at me. He had to be restrained by both Dr. Carter and Dr. Doty both verbally and physically."
