The <u>news</u> that Farhang Niroomand has become the new business school dean at the University of Houston -- Victoria has CoB faculty all jacked up in excitement and anticipation. With AACSB coming back in 2012, dean Lance Nail's Economic Symposium prediction that the economy will need until then or later to rebound has some concerned about re-accreditation.
