The top four places look much like the top four using total Google Scholar citations. In fifth place, however, is Michael Wittmann, an *assistant professor* of marketing with 7.00 GSC per year since terminal degree. Among the top eight positions are Wittmann, Jennifer Sequeira (MGT), Talai Osmonbekov (MKT), and Jie Yang (MGT) – all *assistant professors* in their respective units. With four of the top eight GSC-YSTD producers in the CoB, the Management & Marketing Department appears to have conducted a number of high-quality searches over the past few years, a fact not considered heretofore in any USMNEWS.NET reports or editorials. Contrast this with recent hires in economics, such as Akbar Marvasti (40th), and one has to wonder how long the EFIB can hold on to its reputation as the CoB's leader in scholarship. Marvasti, whose GSCYSTD count is a paltry 0.23, was hired as an *associate professor* in the spring of 2006, and sources tell USMNEWS.NET that he will soon be promoted to *professor*.

The table also shows how insignificant most of the CoB's accountants are when it comes to scholarly profile. Marc DePree (27th) is the only accountant in the Top 30, and Marvin Albin (at 34th) ranks higher than both Stan Clark (37th) and Charles Jordan (39th). Six accountants register at or barely above 0.00 GSCYSTD. These are Jim Henderson (0.11), Robert Smith (0.05), Mary Anderson (0.00), Steven Jackson (0.00), Gwen Pate (0.00), and Roderick Posey (0.00).

Interestingly, *assistant professor* of finance Sean Salter (17th) ranks ahead of *associate professor* of finance John Clark (18th), yet CoB administrators rewarded Clark with \$12,000 in raise money in 2006 while they (in 2007) delivered a terminal letter to Salter. Also, the Management & Marketing assistants mentioned above all rank higher than Jon Carr, a BAC *associate* professor and current holder of the Louis K. Brandt Research Award. Finally, it is also worth noting how far ahead Daniel Monchuk (16th) is from his counterparts in the EFIB, Sami Dakhlia (22nd) and Farooq Malik (29th).
