Godwin Named President of PHCC

Former USM Vice President back in Higher Education Administration

While USM president Martha Saunders is readying to leave higher education administration, former USM vice president for research, Angeline Godwin, is preparing to re-enter that arena after being named as the new president of Patrick Henry Community College in Virginia. The former member of the Shelby Thames administration of USM (2002-07) will be handed the reins of PHCC on 1-July-2012, the same day that Saunders steps back to rank-and-file faculty at USM.

Godwin, who becomes the third president of PHCC, is now the third former member of the Thames administration to hold a higher education presidency. In that situation she joins Tim Hudson, who sits atop Arkansas State University, and Peter Fos, the current president of the University of New Orleans. Hudson served as provost at USM, while Fos was the dean of USM's College of Health. Godwin holds degrees from Gulf Coast Community College, Troy University, University of Alabama, Florida State University, and Thomas Cooley Law School.
