The table above presents 2007 Google Scholar citations data for the CoB's nine accountants. At the top of the list is Marc DePree, editor of USMNEWS.NET, who has 16 citations, accounting for 40 percent of the unit's total count (of 40).¹ Marvin Albin, who constitutes 11.1 percent of the unit, has produced 25 percent of the unit's Google Scholar citations. Interestingly, Albin is an associate professor and his Google Scholar recognition is twice that of Stanley Clark and Charles Jordan, two fulls who have held the Morgan Professorship in accounting. Both Clark and Jordan are just pulling their 11.1 percent weight in the unit.

Former SAIS Director Roderick Posey, also of "more than 100" publications fame, has yet to be Google Scholar cited, as has Steven Jackson, the SAIS' rising Director. Associate professor Jim Henderson, known more for golf than scholarship, has three citations, or 60 percent of the Google Scholar recognition achieved by Clark and Jordan. Once again, these data are eye-opening.
