The table above presents 2007 Google Scholar citations data for the CoB's five finance faculty. At the top of the list is Tom Lindley, who has 346 citations, accounting for 92.5 percent of the unit's total count (of 374). Amazingly, Lindley does not hold a CoB Professorship, and has not for more than one decade. According to sources, it is Lindley to whom former CoB Associate Dean Farhang Niroomand referred as a "has been." Next in line is John Clark, the CoB Financial Services Professor, with 4.5 percent of the unit's Google Scholar recognition.

Like ACC, there are zeros in FIN, with two from Matthew Hood and Weihua Shi. Amazingly, Hood holds the CoB's Banking Professorship, while EFIB Chair George Carter considers Shi a permanent hire for the EFIB (sources say without consultation with EFIB faculty). Unlike ACC, FIN's ranking naturally progresses according to academic rank, though that is not a difficult feat when there are only five slots to include. It is astounding that FIN now finds itself with only four non-visiting faculty members.
