The table above presents 2007 Google Scholar citations data for the CoB's 11 management faculty. At the top of the list are Sharon Topping, a full professor, and Joseph Peyrefitte, an associate professor and Interim Associate Dean, each with 41 citations. This citation total accounts for 16.9 percent of the unit's total (of 243). Though she accounts for only 9.1 percent of the unit's faculty, Topping has produced 16.9 percent of the unit's Google Scholar recognition. This would seem to blunt criticism from Topping's detractors in the CoB.

Close behind are Stephen Bushardt, a full with 15.6 percent of the MGT total, and Jie Yang, an assistant with 15.2 percent of the unit's total. Amazingly, among these four only Peyrefitte holds a CoB Professorship. Yang's total of 37 is remarkable for an *assistant professor*. It is interesting that Jon Carr, an associate professor, BAC Professorship holder, and current Louis K. Brandt Research Award recipient, has produced only 51.4 percent of Yang's Google Scholar citations mark.

Bringing up the rear are David Duhon of "letter of agreement fame," Francis Daniel of "tenure track = infinity" renown, and Kenneth Zantow of "4th Year Review" lore. Like other units, MGT also has zeros in Zantow and Daniel Michael. Sources tell USMNEWS.NET that Michael received a terminal contract after the 2006-07 academic year. Finally, MGT's ranking exhibits some anomalies with respect to Google Scholar cites by rank.
