The table above presents 2007 Google Scholar citations data for the CoB's three one-person area faculty. At the top of the list is Ernest King, an associate professor of legal studies with 138 total citations, accounting for 97.9 percent of the "unit's" total (of 141). Brigitte Burgess, assistant professor of fashion merchandising is second with 3 cites, while John Lamber, assistant professor of international business brings up the rear at 0 cites.

King's count – 138 – is remarkable, and, given how King is often treated, goes to indicate how little CoB administrators know about quality. There are only five (5) faculty in the CoB with more than 100 Google Scholar cites, and King is one of them.
