Interestingly, these are the same credentials held by CoB assistant professor of IB John Lambert, who played an instrumental role in bringing Harrell to the CoB. Sources say that Lambert fought hard for a permanent faculty position in the CoB for Harrell, but he was thwarted by then-interim CoB dean Alvin Williams.

Amazingly Harrell lists (at suno.edu) "teaching areas" in economics, marketing, management, *and* international business. In terms of research interests, Harrell lists entrepreneurship, strategic management and international business. In 2008 she became a new member of the Academy of International Business (AIB).
