"He [Farhang Niroomand] was very agitated. He was very red faced. And I remember him pointing his finger at me and saying, "I ought to kick your ass." At that moment, I said I will never be alone behind closed doors with an administrator at USM ever again. Never again will I without some sort of protection for my self because I thought he could – if he was really – and I'll tell you his reputation at the college, he has a reputation for having a bad temper, and my thought at the time was this guy could come across the room at me, and it would be my word against his, and there would be nothing I could do, and he's been here for 20 years, and I've been here for three, and there would be nothing I could do."

Dr. Saunders was present when this sworn testimony was given in Federal Court. She took no action.
