

# SEDONA Files

In an effort to shed more light on the annual evaluation process in the CoB, this is Part XVII in a series of examinations of CoB faculty SEDONA materials, as they appeared on 2 May 2006, or just after the time of the CoB's annual evaluation. Previous exhibits have pointed out that CoB faculty are responsible for maintaining their CV items on SEDONA, an electronic database. As stated in an e-mail by Dean Doty, SEDONA materials **only** are to be evaluated by CoB administrators at the annual review hearing.

This issue of SEDONA Files takes a look at the CoB's management faculty SEDONA records. As usmpride.com readers are aware, CoB Dean Harold Doty entered the field of management via an undergraduate degree in psychology from Southwest Texas State University in San Marcos, Texas. This is a route into management that Doty reportedly advocates. In this issue of SEDONA Files, we examine the undergraduate education backgrounds of the CoB's management faculty in order to determine how prevalent this avenue into management is (at least among CoB faculty).

Table 1 below lists those CoB management faculty who earned undergraduate degrees in psychology.

Table 1 above indicates that, among the CoB's current management faculty, only CoB Dean Harold Doty and assistant professor of management Kenneth Zantow took the "B.A. in Psychology route" into the management professions.
