As the table shows, USM employed 12 economics faculty just a few short months ago. Soon that number will be down to just three. Yosef Bonaparte was terminated by USM in the spring of 2009. George Carter, was forced to retire by the Martha Saunders administration of USM, as were Trellis Green, William Gunther, Mark Klinedinst and Edward Nissan. Deniz Gevrek recently (Jan-2010) moved from USM to Texas A&M University at Corpus Christi. John Lambert was transferred by CoB dean Lance Nail from economics to management. Farhang Niroomand became dean of business at the University of Houston at Victoria over the summer of 2009. As long-time readers are aware, the three economists who will remain were saved by the Saunders administration after the retirement plan regarding the five mostly senior economists was approved by USM provost Robert Lyman.
