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Enjoying the flight as part of the "Official Party" representing USM were Saunders, Joe Bailey (Saunders' husband), Pam and Doug Rouse (a Hattiesburg doctor and current IHL board member), Troy Johnson, and Doug Davis. The Airplane Operations auxiliary at USM charged Saunders \$4,080 for this trip to Florida. There is no document indicating that Saunders received any payment, partial or otherwise, from the Rouses, Davis, or Johnson that covered their portions of the cost of the journey.

A sizable pile of reports about the Rouses' use of the USM airplane has built up, even before this report hit the public. Given the Rouses' growing friendship with Saunders and Bailey, and Doug Rouse's position with the IHL, constituents of the state's other public universities would be justified in believing that USM is achieving a sort of "insider" status with the IHL board through its use of the Beechcraft King Air.
