Special Report

Consistently Good, Consistently Bad An Investigative Report on Instruction Quality in the CoB

The USMNEWS.NET reports on CoB faculty **pickaprof** and **RATEMYPROFESSORS** teaching quality scores are popular annual entries to the USMNEWS.NET catalogue. In this *Special Report*, we integrate the results from the two separate recent reports in this genre in order to see which CoB faculty offer consistently good, and consistently bad, instruction quality. Each CoB faculty mentioned in the two separate reports is listed alphabetically in Table 1 below. Also listed there is each faculty member's unit, and his or her rank in the CoB according to the **pickaprof** and **RATEMYPROFESSORS** evaluations.

CoB faculty highlighted in blue above exhibit rankings that point towards consistently good instruction quality. There are four CoB faculty fitting the blue ribbon distinction -- Marc DePree (ACC), Ernest King (MIS), Patricia Munn (ACC) and William Smith (MKT). Three separate CoB units are represented by these four top CoB instructors. Interestingly, these four blue ribbon teachers represent the academic ranks of professor (DePree), associate professor (King), assistant professor (Smith) and instructor (Munn).

On the other end of the spectrum are MIS' Kuo Lane Chen, who is arguably the CoB's *worst* teacher, and Wanda Fennell, an instructor of management. If sourced reports are accurate, Chen recently received tenure from USM President Martha Saunders, despite the protests of Interim CoB Dean Alvin Williams and Interim SAIS Director Steven Jackson. On the verge of falling into the bottom category with Chen and Fennell are economists Daniel Monchuk and Edward Nissan. Neither of these has a stellar instructional record.

The placement of Nissan and Chen at or near the bottom of the CoB is even more interesting in light of other reports showing each to be a gut professor. It's one thing to be a hard grader, like Monchuk, and be rated at the bottom of the instruction quality ladder, while it's quite another to exhibit the traits of a free/easy grader and reside there, as do Nissan and Chen. Like so many other problems, this is a situation that will have to be dealt with by new CoB Dean Lance Nail.
