## A Look at the Service Dereliction of the CoB's Former Dean

Reporters at usmnews.net have received tips indicating that former CBA Dean William Gunther is not living up to his service responsibilities. Table 1 below presents data on the CoB's Faculty Senators' presence/absence at Faculty Senate meetings over the past two academic years (i.e., 2005-06 and 2006-07). As Table 1 above points out, over the 2005-07 period former CBA Dean William Gunther (professor of economics) missed 14 of the 16 Faculty Senate meetings that he was expected, as an EFIB (CoB) representative, to attend. This translates into an attendance percentage of just 12.5 percent. Out of Gunther's 14 absences, only six of these (42.9 percent) were covered by a proxy representative. Among these six occasions, CoST Senator Myron Henry served as Gunther's proxy twice (33.3percent). Thus, on those two occasions CoB faculty were represented by a Senator from the College of Science & Technology instead of the one elected to serve by those same CoB faculty.

None of the CoB Faculty Senators' attendance percentages (over 2005-07) shown in Table 2 above is stellar. Only Catherine Price's (professor of tourism management) attendance surpassed the 70 percent mark. Former CoB Director of Graduate Progams and former Chair of Management Stephen Bushardt's attendance rate was just over 60 percent, as was management professor David Duhon's. The overall attendance percentage for the CoB's Senators (over 2005-07) was a disappointing 46.3 percent.

## **Commentary by Duane Cobb**

William Gunther earns \$125,000 per 9-month year. He teaches only two courses each semester, thanks to his appointment as Director of the CoB's Bureau of Business and Economics Research. He does next-to-nothing with the BBER. He lives on a half-million dollar estate in Baldwin County, Alabama. He spends a significant portion of each week driving back-and-forth between Hattiesburg and Josephine, AL. He's not doing academic research. And, as this report shows, he's not doing university service. The taxpayers of Mississippi are getting hosed by William Gunther. Plain and simple.
