## Websites Call for Firing of Monken

With the 13-Nov-2014 loss to San Antonio by a score of 10-12, many USM fans have given up on the Todd Monken administration of USM's football program. To date, Coach Monken has managed to accumulate a grand total of four wins in those two years. According to one comment on BigGoldNation.com, "If y'all don't think we need to fire our whole athletic department I don't know what game y'all were watching we suck." Another comment complains "Head coach doesn't describe anyone on our current staff." In Monken's first year, he managed to win one game. During the 2014 season he has managed to win three games, and is generally expected to lose every other game this season.

given the costs of replacing them -- including paying out their contracts -- sources tell USMNEWS.net that their firings are not forthcoming this year. If so, things will likely get much worse for USM athletics before getting any chance to improve.
