## A Look at How the Powers at USM are Devaluing the CoB and Its Faculty

Recent upgrades to the CoB's website reveals, to sources at least, that the USM business college and its "Faculty" are now being devalued, though there is some uncertainty as to whom to assign the credit/responsibility. An example of what is being referred to here appears in the screen below, taken from the main page of the CoB's management and international business website.



The link above that is circled in red indicates that the department's "Faculty" are now being referred to by CoB and USM administrators as "Teachers." This puts, in the eyes of many, these individuals on the level of the teaching staffs at Pearl River Community College or Jones County Junior College. This link is not confined to only the MIB faculty, it is prevalent throughout the CoB's webpages.



The second insert, above, shows what one finds when accessing the "Teachers" link for the CoB's casino, hospitality, and tourism management department, its smallest. Again the "Teachers" term is visible, only now it is more prevalent than before, included in larger font above the photos of the members of the department. Examples from management/IB, and marketing/fashion merchandising, are inserted below.



USM president Martha Saunders loves to state that USM is the premier research institution of the Gulf South. Being home to "Teachers" only, USM's b-school is apparently *not* a contributor to that particular distinction. In fact, if one were to visit the website of a local high school, what is found on the CoB's webpages above is likely to be found there as well.
