Special Report

James Crockett's Travel: Back to the Beach

An Investigative Series on CoB Travel

This "Special Report" continues a multi-part examination of Employee Travel Vouchers in USM's College of Business. In this report, we examine the interesting details of James Crockett's June 2005 trip to Destin for the MSCPA Annual Convention.

The insert below comes from paperwork submitted by Crockett, and it indicates the dates of the 2005 MSCPA Annual Convention:

This year Crockett stayed at the convention hotel in Destin --- The San Destin Golf and Beach Resort. However, as the insert below indicates, Crockett required a room for 11 people, much like previous trips to Destin:

The insert above also indicates that Crockett arrived on 6/23/05 and departed on 6/26/05.

Because Crockett was housing 10 guests, he needed a large room. The MSCPA sent out an accommodations form prior to the conference. The relevant parts of that form, and Crockett's marked choice, are presented below:

As is evident from the menu above, Crockett selected the "DOCKSIDE 3 BDRM" which was priced at \$329.00 per night. This choice is consistent with what Crockett was charged by the San Destin Golf and Beach Resort, as is evident below:

The three entries above labeled "MS CPA D3" would be in reference to the "MSCPA Dockside 3 [Bedroom]" accommodation choice that Crockett made earlier in the Spring of 2005. Notice the curious entry "DUNES GOLF" for \$37.50 above. We'll get back to that shortly.

Remember that on one previous trip to Destin for the MSCPA that is analyzed at usmpride.com, Crockett submitted the Resort's accommodations pricing list, and USM reimbursed him for lowest available rate only, even though Crockett had stayed in a room that was priced much higher. Of Crockett's three previous trips to Destin analyzed here at usmpride.com, that particular one was the only one that Crockett did not over-bill USM. What happened on this 2005 occasion?

As the insert above indicates, Crockett charged USM \$182.60 per night, presumably sharing the lodging costs with other members of his family. The lowest rate --- \$139.00 for Bayview (see above) --- should have been the maximum charge allowed Crockett for lodging. This means that Crockett over-billed USM about \$29/night (allowing taxes) for three nights, totaling about \$90.

Notice all of the "fixed" reimbursements for meals. In past trips to Destin, Crockett did not include meals on his voucher, noting instead that meals were provided by the MSCPA. He paid a \$205 registration fee in 2005. The MSCPA paperwork submitted by Crockett notes that breakfast and lunch on 6/24 were included, along with breakfast and dinner on 6/25, yet Crockett billed for food (see above) totaling \$34 across those four meals. Thus, Crockett appears to have over-billed for meals as well. The mid-point of the possible range for meal over-billing is about \$58.

Now back to the golf. Some of the paperwork sent out by the MSCPA is a bit curious to our investigators. For example, the MSCPA offered a deep sea fishing outing on 6/24/05, as the insert below indicates.

As you can see above, Crockett took advantage of this opportunity, one that consumed the better part, if not all, of one of the three days he spent "at the conference."

Closing Commentary

There appears, to us at least, to be very little redeeming academic quality to these MSCPA meetings. A significant portion --- about 33% --- of the time Crockett spent "participating" in the 2005 MSCPA Convention was time spent on the golf course. On this and other occasions, these conferences seem to offer little more than an occasion for Crockett to visit with loved ones.

But, that argument aside, there is a bigger issue here, also involving what seems to be Crockett's penchant for combining family vacations, visits to family, and side-outings with academic trips. In one way or another, over-billing is often involved on these occasions. In this instance, the over-billing appears to be about \$150 range. That means, across just 5 conferences (3 in Destin, 1 each in Nashville, TN and Covington, KY), Crockett may have over-billed USM by as much as \$800.
