Gold line above marks the median of the former CoBers.

It is interesting that the median of the former CoBers is in the group with two unique As, right in between Joy Kozar of Kansas State University and Tara Lopez of Southeastern Louisiana University. It is also interesting that Charles Sawyer (ECO) missed the top 5, while Jon Carr (MGT) barely slipped into the top 10. These facts don't support stories told by current and former CoB administrators about the research prowess of these two former CoBers. Finally, the total count on unique As for the former CoBers is 80, producing an average of 2.22.
