

Stan Clark Wins 2010 MSCPA Award

CoB accounting professor Stan Clark (pictured below) recently won the 2010 MSCPA Educator of the Year Award, following his "hero," CoB accounting professor Roderick Posey, who took home the award in 2009. As Van Arnold's [12-Nov-09 presser](#) points out, the Posey-Clark awards of 2009-10 mark the first time in the award's history that same-school accountants have won in successive years. The award was first dispensed in 1987.



Clark told Arnold that winning the 2010 MSCPA award is the "biggest honor" of his academic career, and that following "[his] hero . . . Rod Posey" only added to that honor. CoB accounting director Skip Hughes said that the award is a testament to Clark's commitment as an educator. According to Hughes, Clark ". . . is an exemplar whom we fellow teachers continually aspire to emulate."
