Reporters at USMNEWS.net have noted time and again that the CoB's webpages have failed to note the presence of new faculty members since 2008 (and partially since 2007). Again, as of 14-July-09 there is no evidence of new CoB faculty like Barry Cumbie (MIS), Deniz Gevrek (ECO), Bret Becton (MGT), or Jamye Foster (MKT), etc. Not only that, CoB dean Lance Nail's "Dean's Message" has yet to be uploaded, despite Nail having been on board since 1-July-08.

There probably won't be any takers, especially given all of the facts reflected in the first paragraph above.

Besides traveling on taxpayers' dimes, what do CoB administrators do all day? That's the *real* question of the day, and one that CoB faculty, staff and students should be pondering almost daily these days. Taxpayers are on the hook for the salaries of Nail and his associate dean Joseph Peyrefitte. These total about \$350,000 annually. Where's the beef? There is none, at least as far as one can tell using the CoB's webpages.
