

They're Out

Examining the Departures of the CoB Economists

As the CoB's economists depart the Joseph Greene Hall stage at the end of the 2009-10 academic year, USMNEWS.net examined the research credentials that will be leaving the CoB, if not the institution as a whole. That series focuses on the research of George Carter, Sami Dakhli, Trellis Green, William Gunther, Mark Klinedinst, Akbar Marvasti, Daniel Monchuk, and Edward Nissan. What will the CoB (USM) lose with these departures? That series spells out answers to this question on an individual basis. This report looks at the collection of vitae lines that will exit the CoB with these nine economists. The publications contained on these lines for the nine ECOers are listed in Table 1 below, with A-level journals listed in red font.

As Table 1 above shows, the CoB will be losing 183 total journal publications (counting some duplications), with 22 (12.0%) of these categorized as A-level hits. Interestingly, none of the A-level work includes duplications. The publishing began in 1971 and continues through 2010, while the A-level output started in 1974 and continues through 2010 also. The A-level output is presented on an individual basis in Table 2 below.

Nissan leads the way with six, followed by Dakhliia and Marvasti, who each have four. Many may be surprised to see that Green is tied for 4th with Klinedinst, and ahead of Gunther, Carter and Monchuk. The last two do not yet have any A-level output.

Make of these data what you will. However, when the CoB's Peer Review Team shows up in 2012 and sees the AACSB portfolio, they'll likely wonder why it's so thin. Part of the reason lies here, in the missing 183(+) journal publications from economics.
