

Tracing the Path to Now: Looking Back at George Carter's Misguided Actions

Lawsuit filed against Carter by econ assist prof Trellis Green regarding spring 1994 denial of Green's promotion application Green describes Carter's actions as arbitrary and capricious, and violative of his (Green's) Constitutional rights and "liberty interests." Green also stated that Carter's actions were both malevolent and intentional. Green sought \$800,000 in actual/punitive damages as well as the promotion to associate professor.
