

# President Saunders' Last Days Squandering Students' and Taxpayers' Money

### “One more scandal for the road.”

Let’s repeat that: it cost Mississippi taxpayers and USM students **\$48,415.47** to transport neutered, lame-duck Martha Saunders to Washington, D.C. **for reasons unknown.** We can safely assume that this expensive use of N777AQ was not for the benefit of USM students or Mississippi taxpayers.
