## **Recent Costs and Uses of King Air N777AQ**

As recently reported in "What Would Tattoo Say, New Documents On USM Plane Revealed," usmnews.net recently received documents concerning the most up-to-date costs and uses of King Air N777AQ.

The cash costs for the period of early January 2012 until early July 2012 are \$266,605.50.

<u>Previous cash costs</u> of N777AQ covering the period of March 2009 until December 2011 were \$1,163,207.05.
