## "... Very, Very Difficult Decision" A Look at the Departure of Interim CoB Dean Alvin Williams

As previously report by USMNEWS.NET, the CoB's Interim Dean, Alvin Williams, is set to retire from USM on 30-June-08. Williams' announcement on 12-Nov-07 came as a surprise to many CoB faculty, particularly because the CoB is currently in the midst of a so-called "6th Year Review" with the AACSB, and the visit from the CoB's Peer Review Team is still at least three months away.

Williams' decision has been announced, however, and our reporters have now added Williams to the list of CoB faculty who have (or will have) departed the CoB since the AACSB first visited back in early February of 2007. In adding Williams to that list, reporters have also re-visited an earlier report entitled <u>"Now Holding the Reigns"</u> in order to compile information on the number of publications that Williams will take with him to a new teaching post.<sup>1</sup> That information is included below in Table 1.<sup>2</sup>

As Table 1 above indicates, Williams published 17 articles over the 1980-2007 period. His most productive run came in 1992-1995, a four-year stint wherein Williams produced seven journal publications. Another productive four-year period is found in 1987-1990, when Williams produced four journal publications. On the negative side, Williams has not published a journal article since 2004, and he has published just two since the beginning of 2001. As such, Williams is **not** currently "Academically Qualified," at least not by journal publications, according to the CoB's "3-in-5 years" standard.

Table 2 below continues USMNEWS.NET's look at the numbers associated with the faculty turnover that has occurred in the CoB since early February of 2007, the time the CoB's AACSB Peer Review Team visited and assigned the CoB a so-called 6th Year Maintenance of Accreditation Review (for 2008).

With the addition of Williams to the list, the CoB has lost (or will lose) **13** faculty who have taken (will take) with them no fewer that **132** journal publications. With the addition of Williams, the turnover since early February of 2007 results in a loss of **10.2** articles per faculty across the 13 faculty who have (will have) departed the CoB since Feb-07.
