Will D. Harold Doty's Work Hit the Timbers Nursery? Stephen Bushardt's SEDONA Vita Says So

The second item listed above is an "in press" article by Bushardt and former CoB Dean D. Harold Doty entitled "An Extension of the Configurational Fit Methodology and Support for a Respecification of Mintzberg's Theory." This article is said to be "in press" with the Journal of Current Issues in Finance, Business and Economics.

Using both google.com and ask.com searches, USMNEWS.NET investigators were unable to uncover any information about this journal and its contents. Not only that, it's interesting that Doty does not list this paper nor this journal anywhere on his own SEDONA vita. What is this journal? Does it exist? Does Doty even know his name is on this paper, assuming the paper exists? Will be paper, if it exists, end up at timbersnursery.com at some point in the future? Is Doty now caught up in some smelly research scandal of the sort that seem to be so uniquely CoBish? These and other questions cannot be answered as long as CoB vitae stay secret and CoB faculty continue to publish in obscure (at best) journals.

On Bushardt's vitae, the JCIFBE sits between the Journal of Organizational Culture, Communication and Conflict and the Decisions Sciences Journal of Innovative Education. It (the JCIBFE) is probably used to this neighborhood. Assuming Doty is familiar with this project, it will one day sit cheek by jowl his articles in the *Academy of Management Journal*. These two journals, the AMJ and the JCIFBE, have probably never been situated as close together on a vitae as they will be on Doty's (future version).
