New Bar Complaint filed against Lee Gore

PENSACOLA – On July 1, 2013, a second complaint was filed with the Florida Bar Association alleging Lee Gore, former University Counsel for USM, and current General Counsel/Special Assistant to UWF President Judith Bense, engaged in the unauthorized practice of law.

The [new complaint](#) is particularly interesting as it alleges unlicensed practice of law, including a misreading/misinterpretation of Florida law to justify a breathtaking increase in tuition at UWF.

13. Gore's UPL schemes have been the cause, as least in part, of significant financial hardships for UWF stakeholders. To cite a single example, UWF undergraduate tuition differential (UTD) fees increased by 123% in 2010, by 67% in 2011, and by 82% in 2012. I state additional examples of harm to stakeholders in the exhibits set forth below.
